CIRCULAR NO:10 Inter-House Competitions Wednesday, 29 June 2022

Dear Parents,

The following are the weekly Inter-House Activities / Competitions, to be held on this Wednesday, 29 June 2022 in the school. Certificates will be provided to all the winners. Participation of your ward is expected in all activities & competitions to be conducted by the school. Kindly refer to the Coradius App for month-wise details of Inter House Competitions.

There will be four levels of competitions, namely:

Level 01 = Classes 01 & 02 Level 02 = Classes 03 to 05 Level 03 = Classes 06 to 08 Level 04 = Classes 09 & 10

Details of the competitions are as under:

Classes – I & II

<u>Name of the Competition - Tug of War</u> Time - Zero Period Venue - Sports Field Participants - Selected students of class I & II Teacher In charges - Respective Class Teachers & Department of Sports Rules

- The department of sports to make the students practise the same in games period.
- All the students of class I & II to be divided equally into two teams for Semi Final.
- Sixteen Students to be selected for finals.
- Finals to be conducted on the same day.
- Both Girls & Boys to be selected equally.
- Results to be announced on the same day.

Classes: III, IV & V

Name of the Competition - English Poem Recitation

Time - Zero Period Participants - 04 students from each class. i.e. Four from Class 3, 4 & 5 each. (Selection of the students to be done on the basis of their houses) Venue - Dance Room Topic - Save Tigers House In charges - House Tutors

Rules

- The poem to be recited by students and it should not be from the syllabus.
- The participants to start the recitation with the name of the poem and the poet's name.
- Props can be used by students.
- Time limit 5 minutes.

- The Rating grounds are Introduction which includes, (address to Principal, Teachers, Students & Judges), Expressions, Gestures, Pronunciation, Clarity & Presentation.
- Selection of students to be done for I, II & III Positions.
- The decision of the Judges will be deemed as final and binding.

Classes – VI to VIII

<u>Name of the Competition - Hurdle Race</u>

Time - Zero Period

Venue - Sports Field

Participants - Four Students to be selected from VI to VIII (Boys & Girls teams separately)

Teacher In charges - House In charges & Department of sports.

Rules

- The trials for the race to be conducted during the games periods.
- Four girls & Four boys from each Class to be selected separately for the finals.
- Four students selected for finals should be from different houses.
- Total six teams will participate in final competition.
- Winners will be selected for I, II and III positions from each class and separately for boys & girls.
- The names of the winners to be handed over to the Activity Co-Ordinator the same day.
- The finalist in case he/she participates in improper uniform will be disqualified and other deserving student will be benefited.

Classes – **IX & X** (Interested Participants of Classes XI & XII are also allowed provided they will be as per their houses and required numbers)

<u>Name of the Competition - Mime Competition - Theme: Women Security</u>

Time - Zero Period

Venue – TDC

Participants - Four Students to be selected from IX to XII (Boys & Girls collectively) Teacher In charges - House In charges & Department of sports.

Rules

- The house-wise rehearsal for mime could be done during S. Activity Periods / Sports Periods.
- Suitable Costume and make up should be used. However, the types of costumes and make up should be similar, but the colours, if required could be different.
- Four to Eight participants from each house to be selected.
- Only recorded music can be used during enactment, but no lyrics are permitted.
- Duration of the competition is 3–5 minutes. The house exceeding the time limit will be disqualified.
- Teams using the props, costumes, makeups are to bear the expenses themselves.
- All teams are to be ready for the competition before the start of the competition. No time for stage setting will be given during the competition.
- Criteria for Judgement:
 - a. Costume 05 Marks
 - b. Face Makeup 05 Marks
 - c. Co-ordination 05 Marks
 - d. Props 05 Marks
 - e. Expression 10 Marks
- Winners will be selected for I, II and III positions. The decision of the judges will be final.
