The following are the weekly Inter-House Activities / Competitions, to be held on **Thursday, 07 July 2022** in the school. Certificates will be provided to all the winners. Participation of your ward is expected in all activities & competitions to be conducted by the school. Kindly refer to the Coradius App for month-wise details of Inter House Competitions.

There will be four levels of competitions, namely:

Level 01 = Classes 01 & 02

Level 02 = Classes 03 to 05

Level 03 = Classes 06 to 08

Level 04 = Classes 09 & 10

Details of the competitions are as under:

Classes - I & II

Name of the Competition - Backward Running

Time – Zero Period

Venue: Sports Ground

Participants - All the students of Class I & II.

Teacher In charges – Respective Class Teachers & Department of Sports

Rules

- Separate competition to be organised for the students of class I & II.
- First Semi Final to be conducted followed by Final competition on the same day.
- Four students (Boys & Girls) to be selected for finals separately from class I & II.
- Top three students to be selected for I, II & III position (Boys & Girls separately).
- Names of students securing I, II & III position to be given to Activity co-ordinator.

Classes – III to V

Name of the Competition - Fireless Cooking

Time - Zero Period

Venue – Respective Classrooms

Participants -Interested students of classes III to V

Teacher In charges – Respective House In-charges.

Food Items which can be prepared – Sandwich (Cheese/Vegetable/Cucumber/Tomato), Fruit

Chat, Green Salad, Bhel Puri, Peanut Chat etc.

Material Required for Presentation- Tray, Plate, Spoon, Fork, Foil paper, Tooth-pic, Paper Napkins

Apron, Hand gloves and Head Cover.

Rules

- All the students to get the entire cooking material from home.
- Students will get forty minutes time to prepare their food item.
- Teachers can assist all the students equally.
- Students can get the material required properly cut/chopped/sliced from home.
- The Judgement criteria will be Presentation, Creativity, Taste & Flavour.

Classes - VI to VIII

Name of the Competition - Science Quiz

Time – Zero Period

Venue -TDC

Participants –Four students from each house i.e. One from class VI, Two from Class VII & One from class VIII.

Teacher In charges – House In charges

MCQ, Visual Round, Rapid Fire Round, Audio Round, Audience round.

Rules

- Four students from each house to be selected from classes mentioned above.
- There will five rounds in total.
- Each round will have its own rules & regulations.
- Each team will be asked two questions in each round.
- Each team to select their team captain.
- Answer of team captain will only be accepted.
- A time of 30 seconds will be given to each team to give the answer.
- There will be no negative marking for any wrong answer.
- The decision of the quiz master will be deemed as final & binding.

Name of the Competition - English Story Narration

Time – Zero Period

Venue - Dance Room

No. of Participants - 02 Students from each House

Teacher In charges – Respective House In charges

Rules

- The house in charges to select two students from class IX to XII for the Story Narration Competition.
- Time limit for story narration is 5 minutes.
- Story to be narrated only in English.
- Props are not be used at all.
- The judgement criteria will be Introduction which includes Name of the Narrator and Title of the Story, Clarity, Pronunciation, Expressions & Gestures, Voice Modulation and Style of Narration.
- The first best three students will be declared as winner for I, II & III positions.
