The time slots are provided in order to ensure that there is no overcrowding in classrooms. You are requested to adhere to the timing mentioned above as an internal review meeting with all the subject teachers is also scheduled soon after the PTM. The following are the important points to be kept in mind:

- You are requested to **meet all the subject teachers** teaching your ward to discuss the academic progress of your ward.
- Ensure that you have received the **Date-sheet and syllabus of Unit Test 01** to be held from 21 to 30 July 2022.
- To take your ward's **School Almanac**, to be issued from the school on payment of Rs.250/-
- To pay the **School Fee / Transport Fee**, if pending.

Class 09 & 11:

- To submit the **affidavit and documents**, for **CBSE Registration** of your ward. It may please be noted that the details given by you in the documents / affidavit will be final and the same will be reflected in the CBSE class 10 / 12 marksheet. Thereafter, no correction / modification of First Name, Middle Name and Last Name will be entertained, nor in the case of Date of Birth.
- To pay the **CBSE Registration Fee of Rs.300/-**
- To submit / discuss the **Second Language (Hindi / Sanskrit) selection form**, if pending.

Class 10 & 12:

- To pay the **CBSE Examination Fee** (Rs.2150/- for class 10 and Rs.2600/- for class 12)
- To ensure that your ward has submitted the **Mathematics Option Form** (Mathematics – Standard / Mathematics – Basic) and to discuss the difference between these two subjects with the teachers.

Therefore, you are requested to reach the school tomorrow, Saturday, 16 July 2022 to attend the PTM so that there could be some fruitful discussions with the subject teachers, teaching your ward. Kindly spare an hour from your busy schedule on the said date, as the academic performance of your ward is all the more intense now.
