# **Inter-House Competitions** Wednesday, 10 August 2022

Dear Parents.

The following are the weekly Inter-House Activities / Competitions, to be held on Wednesday, 10 August 2022 in the school. Certificates will be provided to all the winners. Participation of your ward is expected in all activities & competitions to be conducted by the school. Kindly refer to the Coradius App for month-wise details of Inter House Competitions.

There will be four levels of competitions, namely:

Level 01 = Classes 01 & 02

Level 02 = Classes 03 to 05

Level 03 = Classes 06 to 08

Level 04 = Classes 09 & 10

Details of the competitions are as under:

# Classes - I & II

Name of the Competition: Hindi Poem Recitation

Time - Zero Period

Participants – 04 students from each class.

i.e. Four from Class I & Four students from Class II.

(Selection of the students to be done on the basis of their houses)

Venue - Dance Room

Topic - Any Poem (Not from syllabus)

Teacher In charges - Respective Class Teachers.

#### **Rules**

- The poem should not be from the syllabus.
- The participants to start the recitation with the name of the poem and the poet's name.
- Props can be used by students.
- Time limit 5 minutes.
- The Rating grounds are Introduction which includes, (address to Principal, Teachers, Students & Judges), Expressions, Gestures, Pronunciation, Clarity & Presentation.
- Selection of students to be done for I, II & III Positions
- The decision of the Judges will be deemed as final and binding

# Classes - 3 to 5

Name of the Competition - Maths Quiz

Time - Zero Period

Venue -Computer Lab

No. of Participants – 04 Students from each house Teacher In charges – Respective House In charges

## Rules

- All the four houses to select four students from class III to V i.e. one from class-3, two from class-4 & one class-5.
- Students to prepare for the quiz according to the topics relevant to their classes.
- There will be total five rounds
- Each round will have its own rules and regulations.
- Each team to select their captain or spokesperson to answer the questions.
- Each team will get thirty seconds to answer the question.
- The decision of the guiz master will be final and binding.

## Classes - 6 to 8

# Name of the Competition - Kho-Kho Final Match

Time - Zero Period

Participants -Selected students of VI to VIII (Boys & Girls Separately).

Venue - Sports Field.

Teacher In charges - Department of Sports and House In charges.

Judges - Department of Sports.

## Rules

- The department of sports to take Semi Final Round during games period (for both girls and boys separately).
- Final Matches to be conducted on the day of the competition and students to be selected as winners for I, II & III positions.
- Students to be allowed to play only in house uniform. If not in sports uniform, then the student will be disqualified.
- The list of winners to be submitted on the same day to the Activity Co-ordinator.
- There are 2 innings in a match.
- An inning consists of Chase & Defence turns which are for 9 minutes each.
- There is an interval of 6 min after every inning & 3 min break between two turns.
- Therefore, 9+3+9+6+9+3+9 = 48 min
- But if scores are equal after 2 innings then there is another inning (i.e. Each team gets chance to Chase and Defend).

## Classes - 9 & 10

# Name of the Competition - Spell Bee Competition

Time – Zero Period

Venue -TDC

Participants – Four students from each house to be selected i.e. two from class IX and X separately. Teacher In charges – House In charges

#### Rules

- A team of 4 students selected by House In charges from each house to participate in it. •
- A team must select a captain or spokesperson to answer the questions and to avoid confusion.
- There will five rounds in total. •
- The participants will get 30 seconds time to answer the question.
- Rounds will be based on grammar syllabus of classes IX & X.
- Spell the word correctly.
- Unscramble the word
- Choose the correct spelling
- Fill in the missing letters (with the help of the clues given)
- There will be no negative marking.
- The Best three teams will be selected for I, II & III positions.
