CBSE CLUSTER-XII ATHLETICS CHAMPIONSHIP 2025-26 GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

- 1. The rules as adopted by the athletics Federation of India apply, with modifications wherever applicable.
- 2. Participating schools are requested to send their confirmation by email latest by 20th August 2025.
- **3.** Teams are requested to inform the exact time of arrival to enable us to receive the teams at railway station, failure to which will lead to making of their own arrangements.
- (a) Schools affiliated to CBSE under independent category and managed by Army, Navy, Air force, Defence, Railways, CRPF, Police, Assam Rifles, Para-Military, BSF, PSUs and other such central agencies, are also eligible to participate in CBSE Games, subject to remittance of Annual Sports Fee to CBSE must attach the proof of payment of Annual Sports Fee.

Note: Only online registration of participants with proper UID number & online entry Performa as submitted on CBSE Website will be accepted.

- **4.** GD GOENKA PUBLIC SCHOOL will provide accommodation to the registered terms in the school campus on first come first serve basis.
- **5.** No team will be allowed to participate without Team Manager/Coach. Female Coach/Manager mandatory with girls' team.
- **6.** Participants are requested not to bring valuable items such as jewellery, mobile, camera, iPods etc, as use of these items in the campus is at their own risk.
- 7. Boarding and lodging will be available from 27th August 2025 evening.
- 8. The participants must carry their registration card at the time of the CHAMPIONSHIP duly filled and signed by the Head of the Institution, valid for the current year. Participants of Class X / XII must carry IX / XI Class board registration cards respectively, XI Class students should carry their X Class mark sheet issued by CBSE and for other classes birth certificate issued by Municipal Corporation should be attached to ensure date of birth. All should be duly attested by the Principal of the participating school with Unique ID no. given at online CBSE registration.
- 9. All the Athletes should be within the particular age group as on December 31, 2025.

An Athletes must be under 14, 17, & 19 years of age as on 31st Dec of the year of

Accordingly, for session 2025-26 sports events, the age criteria will be as follows:

- 1. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2012
- 2. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2009
- 3. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2007
- 10. Protest of any nature should reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer in writing within 15 minutes of the declaration of the result. It should be accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Non Refundable).
- 11. Teams have to report to the host school before 06:00 p.m. on 27th August 2025.
- 12. A Managers' Meeting will be held at 07:00 p.m. on 27th August 2025.
- **13.** Teams without online registration and proper eligibility forms will not be allowed to participate in the Championship.
- **14.** Consumption of non-vegetarian food, alcohol, tobacco chewing and smoking is strictly prohibited in the campus. Violators would be immediately asked to leave the premises/ meet.
- **15.** Team manager will be responsible for the conduct of team on and off the field. Indiscipline by a team member will lead to disqualification and the team member may be asked to leave the premises immediately.

- **16.** The Organizers reserve the right to debar a participant/ Team and Coach/Manager from the CHAMPIONSHIP for unruly behavior/ interference in the smooth conduct of events.
- 17. An amount of Rs. 500/- per day per person for the arrangements of the boarding, lodging & meals.
- 18. A security amount of Rs. 3000/- (refundable) has to be deposited by each team on the date of reporting.
- **19.** All the participating teams should carry their two school flags and other necessary kit, documents etc. as per the instructions of the CBSE.
- **20.** The March past is compulsory for all the participating teams. They should be in their complete Sports Kit for the March past.
- **21.** Athlete/Team must report at least 30 minutes in advance in the call Room.
- 22. You are advised to go through the CBSE Rules and Regulations 2025 related to the event.
- **23.** Team members are not allowed to move around the school and in the School campus. All are expected to maintain decency and proper decorum.
- **24.** Outsiders apart from escort teachers are not allowed to come in the school campus.
- 25. The school will not be responsible for any loops, illness or accident, which may occur during tournament.
- **26.** The Team Managers and Coaches are supposed to stay with their teams.
- **27.** The contingent should bring necessary clothing (according to the climatic condition of Gwalior) and mattresses, & pillows will be provided by the school.
- **28.** All participants are advised to carry their own mosquito repellents, lock & key for safety.
- **29.** The contingent must not cause damage to GD GOENKA PUBLIC SCHOOL Property. In case of any damage the participating team will have to bear the cost.
- **30.** The team officials are requested to complete all the formalities and clear all the payments before their departure.
- **31.** It is not obligatory on the part of organizing school to provide food/transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements. Also, it is the responsibility of school/team staying outside to collect information in regard to matches/ fixtures/programs.
- **32.** Every day last entry in the campus will be by 7.00 p.m. After 7.00 p.m. no team members will be allowed to go out of the campus without permission.
- **33.** The departing teams are requested to inform two hours prior from their departure to the Accounts Department for clearance of their accounts and for arranging the transport.

RULES OF DISQUALIFICATION

A Athlete/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons:

- 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected
- 2. Inclusion of non bonacardfide student in the team
- 3. Misbehaviour on ground by athlete or accompanying official/s
- 4. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official/s
- 5. Misbehaviour or with Officials/Opponents by athlete or accompanying official/s
- 6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official/s
- 7. Damaging the school property
- 8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official/s

Offline entry or any type of correction in entry on the spot will not be entertained.
